VAYU Advanced Wound Clinic and Hyperbarics is now providing state-of-the-art clinical wound care and hyperbaric medicine. While the patient's primary care provider maintains overall care for the patient, we treat the wound while providing a case management approach that optimizes the continuum of care.

Any patient with a problem wound that has not started to heal in two weeks should see a wound care specialist. Non-healing wounds can cause infection, lower quality of life & even lead to limb amputations when associated with poor perfusion & non-offloading.

INDICATIONS FOR WOUND THERAPY

- Ulcers (diabetic, ischemic, neuropathic, pressure)
- Venous Insufficiency
- Collagen Vascular Disease/ Auto-Immune Disease
- Trauma
- Surgical Wounds
- Burns



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HYPERBARICS

Hyperbaric oxygen therapy is very effective in treating a wide range of conditions either as a standalone therapy or in combination with another therapy. The FDA currently recognizes HBOT for the following conditions, which are generally covered by insurance:

- Diabetic Wounds of the Lower Extremity
- Refractory Osteomyelitis
- Delayed Radiation Injury
(soft tissue & bony injury)
- Compromised grafts & flaps
- Acute Thermal burns
- Air or Gas embolism
- Carbon-monoxide poisoning
- Clostridial Myositis and Myonecrosis
(Gas Gangrene)
- Crush Injury, Compartment syndrome
- Decompression Sickness
- Arterial Inefficiencies/Central Retinal artery Occlusion (CRAO)
- Severe Anemia
- Necrotizing Soft-tissue infections
- Idiopathic sudden Sensorineural hearing loss.
